INSIDE OUT

The provision of flexible educational workshops working with ex-offenders and exploring issues around anti-social behaviour, youth and street crime in schools, youth clubs and youth programmes.

BRACE

(Building Relationships Amongst Cultures Everywhere)

The Brace campaign provides workshops and road shows in schools to educate young people on resolving issues of conflict between different communities by, promoting respect, raising cultural awareness, building relationships and challenging stereotypes.

THE YOUTH LEADERSHIP CENTRE

An early intervention programme to develop the leadership potential of young people who may be identified as being at risk of offending.

LEADERSHIP BREAKFAST MEETINGS

Unique development, networking and information sharing opportunities for local people and leaders from the statutory, faith, voluntary and community sectors, victims/family of victims of crime, black and minority groups, young people and ex-offenders.

WHAT'S THE POINT

A focused anti knife campaign targeted at youths between the ages of 11-19 with the Whats the Point comic book which is widely recognised by young people as an effective way to get the message across.

UNTOUCHABLE

An educational resource pack with a video to provide young people with an understanding of the issue of gun crime, its underlying causes and how to avoid the pitfalls. These packs are provided to schools, faith organisations and community centres.
